Lake County Farm Bureau 2021 Agricultural Scholarship Application

The Lake County Farm Bureau Scholarship is organized to provide financial assistance to Lake County students who show a desire to pursue a career in the agricultural industry. The scholarships are awarded annually and are based upon academic achievement, career goals, extracurricular activities, determination, leadership skills, and a commitment to study agriculture. The LCFB Scholarship is open to all Lake County high school students or graduates who are enrolled in an accredited college or university that offers courses in any of the agricultural fields or vocations.

How to Apply

Complete the application and attach an official transcript of your courses if available at the application deadline; otherwise provide a current record of your grades. You must also include two letters of recommendation and an essay that describes your past, present and future in agriculture.

Scholarship applications are available February 2, 2021. Applications must be postmarked or received by the Lake County Farm Bureau office no later than **April 9, 2021**. Application forms can be downloaded at www.lakecofb.com and will also be available at the LCFB office.

General Requirements

The following requirements apply to all Lake County Farm Bureau scholarships:

- Applicant must be enrolled in or have graduated from a high school located in Lake County, California.
- Scholarships may be applied at an accredited college or university of the applicant's choice which offers courses leading to a certificate or degree in a recognized profession or vocation in agriculture.

- Applicants who are awarded a scholarship are required to verify proof of enrollment with the Lake County Farm Bureau before funds can be distributed. All scholarships awarded by the Farm Bureau are to be claimed within one (1) year of the date of award, unless specifically extended by the Farm Bureau. These funds may be used for valid educational expenses. Any part of the award not used by the deadline date will be forfeited.
- Incomplete applications and applications not postmarked by the **April 9, 2021** deadline will be automatically disqualified from judging. It is the applicant's responsibility to see that all forms are completed and returned to the Farm Bureau office by the submission deadline.

Checklist for Required Documents Completed Scholarship Application

- Completed application
- Typed or legibly handwritten essay by applicant. Essay should include: why did you choose the school you did and why did you choose agriculture as an area of study? How will this scholarship help you? What are your ag-related past activities, including your participation in 4-H, Grange, FFA, or other organizations? Include any leadership experiences and your participation in other volunteer-related programs or projects.
- Copy of Official Transcript and proof of enrollment in an agriculture-focused major
- Two current and dated letters of recommendation
